### Easter and beyond

I don't know if it is just me, but March seems to have just flown by and I can't believe we are now over half way through Lent, with Holy Week and Easter fast approaching.

During Holy Week there will be a daily opportunity to attend an act of worship. On Thursday, Friday and Saturday these will be the **Triduum liturgies** and include the washing of feet, the stripping of the altars and the veneration of the cross, before the kindling of the new fire and renewal of baptismal vows on Easter Eve as we celebrate the first Eucharist of Easter. Details of all the services can be found on the back of the newsletter.

In addition to the services at St John's, Bishop Alan has invited everyone in the Diocese to attend the **Chrism Mass in St Albans Abbey (11am)** on Maundy Thursday, when the oils used for sacramental ministry in the parish are blessed. It is also a time where both clergy and lay people recommit themselves to ministry and mission.

On **Easter Day** we will baptise three of our children and young people, so do pray for Kristodea, OJ and Odell as they prepare for this special moment in their life. Do also pray for Meg who will be **confirmed on Easter Eve**.

Looking further ahead, I am pleased to announce that at the end of May, we will host a large community event at St John's - details are being finalised at the moment and I will have more info for next month's newsletter.

In June, there will the first of a series of Jazz concerts at St John's, when internationally acclaimed Italian pianist and singer-songwriter Ilario Ferrari joins forces with award-winning jazz/soul singer and producer Randolph Matthews for a special duo performance. Tickets are now on sale, more info on the back of the newsletter.
